1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

This financial report has been prepared for use by the directors and members of the company and is a special purpose financial report. The directors have determined that the business is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the following Australian Accounting Standards: AAS 5 Materiality, AAS 8 Events Occurring After Reporting Date

No other applicable Accounting Standards, Urgent Issues Group Consensus Views or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The report is also prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and except where stated does not take into account changing money values or current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this report for Australian Council for Educational Leaders Inc:

(a) **Property, plant and equipment**

Property, plant and equipment are carried at cost, independent or directors' valuation. Excluding freehold land, all assets are depreciated over their useful lives to Australian Council for Educational Leaders Inc.

(b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost or net realisable value. Costs are allocated on a first-in first-out (FIFO) basis.
